

COVID-19 DASHBOARD



Typical Board Month

Board Workshop: Workshops can last 4 to 6 hours long. Our board learns about items that will be presented at the regular board meeting for approval. They can take a deeper dive and ask questions on items presented. These are held once a month.

Board Briefing: Monthly 1 to 1 conferences with the Superintendent. These meetings tend to last about 2 hours. This is an opportunity to ask any clarifying questions.

Board Meetings: Meetings can be between 2 to 3 hours long. These are held once a month. It is at these meetings that Board of Trustees approve all items on our Consent Agenda, if they believe it is in the best interest of the district.




Site Assignments and Hours



II for Quality School Process

Phase 1 - Application Review

- *Purpose*: Execute an objective evaluation of the application rubric.
- *Participants*: Department Representatives, Community Members, Senior Leadership Team.

Phase 2 - Capacity Interview

- *Purpose*: Interview applicant and complete summary rating of the application.
- Participants: Senior Leadership Team and Community Members.

Phase 3 - Debrief and Final Recommendations

- Purpose: Based on the application review and capacity interview, make a final recommendation to enter contract negotiations.
- *Participants*: Superintendent, Deputy Superintendent, Chief of Staff, and Chief Innovation Officer
