

Performance Objective 1: READING-Domain 1

Based on District Data Analysis for 2022 STAAR:

- -Increase the percentage of students meeting the Approaches Grade Level from 49% to 90% on overall reading for 3rd-5th.
- -Increase the percentage of 3rd grade students meeting the Approaches Grade Level from 47% to 90% on reading STAAR.
- -Increase the percentage of 4th grade students meeting the Approaches Grade Level from 53% to 90% on reading STAAR.
- -Increase the percentage of 6th grade students from 49% (5th grade student data) Approaches to 90% on reading STAAR.
